Sarasota Chapter

The Sarasota Chorus of the Keys recently awarded Sheridan E. Brown Memorial Scholarships to four high school seniors who have demonstrated outstanding musical achievement and will be pursuing a vocal or instrumental college curriculum. Chorus President Jeffry Olesen presented scholarships totally \$9000 to Jonathan Bruzon and Jacob Harvey of Riverview High School, David Linkenhoker of Bradenton Christian School, and Luca Stine, Homeschool & State College of Florida.

The awards were given to the students at chorus rehearsals on April 30th and May 7th. The funding source for the scholarships is the Sheridan E. Brown Memorial Scholarship Fund. The Fund, now valued over \$100,000, was established from estate gifts donated through the wills of chorus members and their spouses.

The April 30th ceremony has 3 of the 4 students pictured: Jonathan Bruzon, David Linkenhoker, and Jacob Harvey. The May 7th ceremony (two photos) shows Luca Stine with President Olesen and with Luca's mother.

pella harmony since 1949.

If you were in Orlando for the Spring convention (or in Salt Lake City for International) and













