As is always the case when barbershop music is in the air, a good time was had by all!









BOD Report

In October, we held another successful District convention, but attendance wasn't as high as normal due to several of the larger choruses sitting out.

The Society has published the Everyone in Harmony contest rules. They have selected what was termed as Option 1 – separate Champions in each group, with no overall winner. It is yet to be determined how this will effect the districts going forward.

I traveled to Cocoa High School representing the District as part of a ceremony to surprise Dr. Misty Martinez with the 2020 BHS/NAfME Music Educator of the Year Award. She was nominated by the Melbourne Chapter, backed by letters from dozens of her students. The award will formally be presented at MidWinter in January. Joe Cerutti flew in to make the presentation for NAfME, This is the 2nd year in a row that a Florida Educator has been selected as Educator of the Year (the 2019 winner was Debbie Cleveland). This is a great coup for both the District and music education in the State! Dr. Martinez has stated that the chapter approached her several years ago and has had a profound effect on both her and the students (one has actually joined the chapter, and sings on a weekly basis).


