Rehearsals

- There are 7 choruses competing in this contest.
- Only choruses that request a Friday night rehearsal will have a space and time assigned for Friday night. Rehearsals will begin after the Quartet semi-finals session has concluded. The District only supplies risers for the stage and the final warmup room (5 sets), so you should assume that there are no risers available. Saturday final warmup rooms have been assigned, and are listed on the loop schedules. You will have 28 minutes there, and will go directly to back stage from there.

- Individual scoring analysis and evaluation schedules will be provided by the Contest Administrator next to the stage immediately following contest.
