What a great weekend we had in the Sunshine District! We had 19 quartets in the Quartet competition and the top ten competitors in the Finals all scored 71% or higher. A great accomplishment for the district! Also, eleven of the nineteen quartets were new in that they had not competed previously.

Taking top honors was **Three and a Half Men** with score of 2244 or an average of **93.5%**, in second place was **Tonal Fusion** with a score of 1901 or an average of **79.2%**. Of note was that **Joseph DeRosa** sang Tenor in **Three and a Half Men** and Baritone in **Tonal Fusion**! Placing third in the competition was **Suite Life** with a score of 929 or an average of **77.1%**.

The quartet competition also selected Sunshine District's representative to International Senior Quartet Competition to be held in January 2024 in New York City. **Right on Q** won the honors with a score of 863 or an average of **72.0%**.

In the Chorus competition for the right to represent Sunshine District at the International

Chorus contest in July 2024 in Cleveland, OH, Heralds of Harmony under the direction of Tony DeRosa and Clay Hine, took the honors with a score of 1084 or an average of 90.3%. The Big Orange Chorus under the direction of Daniel Pesante, took second place honors with a score of 898 or an average of 74.8%. Third place was secured by the Miamians directed by Alex Rubin and Eddie Mejia with a score of 892 or an average of 74.2%.

Tallahassee Chapter Capital Chordsmen

The Capital Chordsmen from the Tallahassee chapter return to the competition risers this year with their new director, Norman Young, and several new members. In addition, for the first time, the chorus' longest standing quartet, Four Oysters in Search of a Pearl, will also enter the competition stage. Both return for two events:

First is an annual favorite among the Chordsmen: the Joe Breedon Panhandle Music Festival, hosted by the Emerald Coast Chapter. It is a weekend gathering of harmony enthusiasts from the Florida Panhandle, held this year on Sep 15 – 17. This is a Barbershop Harmony extravaganza, with male & female choruses, a mass-chorus concert on the last night (combined with youth chorus from the Emerald Coast area). The event features contests for both quartets and choruses. Other events include a 'Krazy Quartet Contest', lots of tag singing in the evenings, with the last event being a bonfire & picnic 'sing-around'....where quartets & choruses share some of their favorites.

Then, only four short weeks later, the *Capital Chordsmen* return to the risers at the Sunshine District Fall convention in St. Augustine. The Chordsmen have not competed since 2018 when they had 36 voices. Covid created a serious loss of members for various reasons: Fear of contact, loss of interest, family health issues. Active membership dwindled to around 12 active singers. In the last two years, however, they picked up new members (one was a Valentine recipient purchased by his wife). The annual show for 2023 had 20 singers. The chorus has 22 active and four inactive members.

Everyone knows the Barbershop world is aging: The Chordsmen were no exception, with ages averaging 60 in 2009, and by 2015 had grown to a ripe 66-age average. The recent growth in membership, however, has dropped that average back to 60.1. The Chordsmen hope those trends continue.

The Capital Chordsmen are diligently working on the music for their 2023 Holiday Show, which will be presented at the Tallahassee Senior Center on Dec 7th & 12th @ 7pm.. This event is open to the public. All seats \$10, with tickets at the door and already on our website at: www.capitalchordsmen. com/tickets

The show committee is co-chaired by our director, Norman Young, and our current scholarship recipient, Timothy Yu. The show includes many songs never before performed by the Chordsmen chorus and the quartets.



Dr. Clare McCreary Joined the Heavenly Choir Nov 15th, 2023

There are legendary barbershoppers whose

names we all know. For every one of those however, there are dozens of heroes who never won a gold medal, but who have served as the glue who have held this artform together, influencing hundreds of lives, inspiring them, educating them, and helping them blossom as artists.

Dr Clare McCreary joined the heavenly choir November 15th, 2023. Clare was not only the oldest member of the Society at 107, he was the oldest competitor to ever cross the contest stage, which he did in Sunshine District, at the ages of 100 and 101, with his quartet, "The Dr. Is In".

Clare was a barbershopper for over 75 years, and there is no telling how many people's lives he touched and how many hearts were lifted, but it was many. In his barbershop life, he was an avid woodshedder, arranger, coach, director, vocal pedagogist, chorus member, and sang in too many quartets to count. One of his most notable was "The Ringmasters" (this was 50+ years before those Swedish kids were even a glimmer in their parent's eyes). He also wrote and edited the award-winning newsletter, "Scoops and Swipes".

Clare and his wife June, were married just days after Pearl Harbor, and after World War II, they moved to St. Petersburg Florida. Clare was an orthodontist, and he and three dentists formed a quartet, called "The Dentalodians". The four wives formed a quartet, "The Dental Flossies". Clare always joked that they had done it in "self-defense". He joined the *St. Petersburg Chorus*, which ultimately became

the Greater Pinellas Chapter (AKA The Florida Suncoast Chorus) and held many offices and was barbershopper of the year numerous times.

At his recent 107th birthday party, Clare sang in two quartets and performed a solo "Young at Heart". He was indeed young at heart, always welcoming change, enthusiastically supporting "Everyone in Harmony". What did he want for his 100th birthday? A 3D printer of course. No doubt, to crank out pitch pipes. But into his second century he was still playing tennis three days a week, driving, and wagging his finger at quartet mates who didn't know their notes and words, or sang "barber-choppy".

He was a kind man, a loving man, and a role model for many. He and June were a romance for the ages. On a personal note, there were two great men in my life, my father and Clare. Clare was my "barbershop dad", and every blessing I've had in my life resulting from barbershop, I owe to him. At various times he told me "The only part worth singing is baritone", "you need to be in a quartet", "you should really be woodshedding", "you need to learn music theory", "you should be a Director". I did all those things, and my life was forever altered...for the better.

Dr. Clare never won a gold medal, but if you remember that famous speech by Jim Henry about "Gold Medal Moments", Clare made those gold-medal moments possible for so many singers over the years.

One of the coolest things ever is that with the recent rebirth of the St. Petersburg chapter (AKA *The Sunshine City Chorus*) Clare was a charter member. So he started in the St. Petersburg Chapter, and ended in the St Petersburg Chapter. We were honored to have him.

As long as there is a tag to sing and a chord to ring, his memory will be a blessing.


