Since our last edition of the Sunburst, we've had opportunities for a great Holiday season, LEADAC, BHS MidWinter in Pasadena, Singing Valentines and maybe even some of our first round of winter and spring shows!! We always love to hear from you all so keep those chapter articles coming throughout the year!

As far as all things barbershop to look forward to this year (among other events):

We as a district are looking at further ways to serve our membership so among other things, we are looking for input about potentially expanding the use of our facilities for the June Harmony Explosion Camp to provide Harmony University classes and/or quartet coaching opportunities for our regular members and maybe even some kind of additional performance opportunities that weekend (look for more communication on those topics). Also, to further serve members, we're assembling a Coaching Guild that can help with chorus coaching as well as chapter coaching for district leadership. Look for additional communication from our Director of Music and Education on that topic. Lastly, we are considering moving up the timeframe for LEADAC so this would become a November event rather than a January start of the year event (just to give new district officers an earlier start on their efforts in January of each year!). This is something we'll be talking about in greater detail at the Spring Convention but wanted to make you aware that this is something we've been considering as a future change to our annual event schedule.

Thanks to all of our district and chapter volunteers for the ongoing services you provide – you all are what makes the Sunshine District as great as it can be!! I sure hope all y'all are fired up for another great year of Sunshine District Barbershop!! Cheers!!

## Fall Was Wonderful. Now, Back to St. Augustine.

*Spring Convention is just around the corner, and the Sunshine District is ready to do it again.*

If the **Fall Contest** reminded us of anything, it is that the **Sunshine District** still knows how to put on a first-rate weekend. The music was strong, the fellowship was stronger, and the whole thing came together in that very Sunshine way: a great deal of effort behind the scenes, with just enough polish to make it all look easy. The District's Fall 2025 recap notes **15 quartets competing, 8 finalists, and Tribute** taking the District Championship, which is a fine reminder that Sunshine knows how to bring both quality and energy to a contest weekend.

Now it is time to look ahead to **SUN Spring Convention 2026**, coming up **Friday, May 1 through Saturday, May 2**, as we return to the **World Golf Village Renaissance in St. Augustine** for the third straight year. The official convention page lists *Jacksonville's Big Orange Chorus* as host chapter, with **Stephen Goldman** serving as organizer and convention chair. By now, most of us ought to know our way around the place, or at least know how to walk briskly in the wrong direction and still look like we meant to.

Stephen is hitting his stride this go-round, taking hold of the process, tightening things up, and continuing the work of making sure **Sunshine District** Events remains one of the premier event teams in the Society. A good convention weekend always looks smooth from the outside. That usually means somebody has been working very hard on the inside, and Stephen has certainly been doing just that.

We are also delighted to welcome **Jesus Pacheco**, pronounced Pah-Chay-Koh, who posts on Facebook as **David Jesus**, which is either artistic flair, bold branding, or both. He will be making

the rounds at convention taking candid photos, so please begin practicing your candid face now. Better to work on it at home than to discover in the hotel lobby that your natural expression suggests deep concern over riser placement, parking, or whether the coffee is still out.

A quick practical note: **registration has moved from Eventbrite to Zeffy** this year, so the checkout process will look a little different. The District's convention page says the new system accepts **credit card, Apple Pay, and Google Wallet**, and that attendees will be given the opportunity to add a donation to Zeffy during checkout. That donation is **optional**, but if you leave the amount on the screen as shown, you are helping keep **Zeffy free for the Sunshine District**. If you would rather adjust it, you can choose "Other" and enter any amount you wish, including \$0.00.

And while we are on the subject of practical matters, please do yourself a favor and **check the District website first** for registration, hotel information, schedules, and competitor details. Truly. It is all there. The homepage currently lists **April 2** as the end of early-bird registration and **April 8** as the hotel reservation deadline, which means the time for "I'll get to it later" is drawing to a close.

On a personal note, I had the pleasure of installing the incoming **Sarasota Chapter** Board this January at an installation brunch, which remains one of the more civilized ideas I have seen in some time. The entire District Board looks forward to seeing as many of our members as possible for what is shaping up to be an excellent contest and convention weekend.

Happy Spring, Sunshine District! I hope your Valentines efforts went well, and love through song was shared all over Florida (and Southeast Georgia).

Here at the SUN Communications desk, I've been heading up a migration to Zeffy for our district donations and shopping cart needs. I'm sure you've seen us mention it if you read the last issue of the Sunburst or have gone through the new convention registration process.

Zeffy offers nonprofits like SUN and its chapters free ways to accept money for various purposes, from folks like you and your audiences. Merchandise and Ticket sales as well as tax-free donation campaigns can easily be set up and managed from a [single web site](#) that's about as hard to configure as Google Forms. Some merch campaigns may also offer you the option of adding a tax-free donation to general SUN Operations on top of your purchase. Payments and donations made to us through Zeffy include the Entire payment amount, with nothing removed for credit card or payment processing fees. This is a big deal at-scale.

Zeffy's angle to providing this management and payment system for free is that they ask the Buyer to optionally kick in a little during checkout. The donor or buyer can choose from suggested service charges (15% and up - watch for it) or add their own custom amount to help support Zeffy (NOT Sunshine). Zeffy is helping us and many other nonprofits out, so please do feel free to return the favor. If you're interested in using Zeffy as a shopping cart or donor management system for your own chapter or any other nonprofit, please drop me a line at [Communications@SunshineDistrict.org](mailto:Communications@SunshineDistrict.org) for an invite code, or scan below.


